

# Sweetheart Glovelets

Designed by *The Rainey Sisters*

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*Warm hands, warm heart!*

Materials: Jade Sapphire's 4-ply cashmere called Keja (red), 4 ply 100% Mongolian Cashmere, 200 yds/55 gm, or other light dk weight luxury yarn

Needles: US 3, straight or circular (for cast on) and dpns (or size needed to obtain gauge)

Gauge: 24 sts and 32 rows to 4"

Directions: For Small/Medium are given, with Large/Extra Large in ( )

Finished Size: 7 1/2" (8") diameter across widest part of hand



## Cuff (left and right glovelet)

With straight or circular needle, cast on 84 (90) sts. \*K2, [bind off 3 sts as follows: k2 sts, pass 1<sup>st</sup> st over 2<sup>nd</sup>, k1, pass st over st just worked, k1, pass st over st just worked -- leaves 1 st on right-hand needle plus the sts already worked], rep from \* to end of row; 42 (45) sts. Distribute sts to 3 dpns, place marker and join without twisting to work in the round. Knit one round, inc 1 st for size Large/Extra large only 42 (46) sts.

\*K2tog, yo\* to end of round. Purl 2 rounds. Knit all rounds for 3 1/2" or desired length of cuff.

## Left Glovelet

NOTE: The thumb is positioned closer to the palm so that the heart design will be centered on the back of the hand

Start thumb gusset: See Chart for correct size on following pages. Read chart from right to left on all rounds. Bold lines indicate marker placement.

Round 1 of chart: Knit 19 (21) sts, place marker, YO, place marker, knit to end of round. Row 1 of chart worked.

Continue working chart until Round 23 (26) is complete. Next Round: Knit 19 (21) palm sts, place 15 (17) thumb gusset sts on waste yarn, cont across back of glovelet, following chart as established. Cont until all 27 (29) chart rows have been worked. Knit 10 rounds plain (or to 1/2" less than desired length).

Top Band: \*K2tog, yo\* to end of round. Purl 1 round. Bind off as to purl.

Thumb: remove sts from waste yarn and distribute evenly on 3 dpns. Join new yarn. Knit 15 (17) sts and pick up 2 sts across gap at base of palm 17 (19) sts. Knit 4 rounds. K1, \*YO, k2tog\* rep betw \* \* to end of round. Purl 1 round. Bind off as to purl.

## Right Glovelet

Start thumb gusset: See Chart for correct size on following pages. Read chart from right to left on all rounds. Bold lines indicate marker placement.

Round 1 of chart: Knit 23 (25) sts, place marker, YO, place marker, knit 19 (21) palm sts. Row 1 of chart worked.

Continue working chart until Round 23 (26) is complete. Next Round: Work 23 (25) chart sts, place 15 (17) thumb gusset sts on waste yarn, cont across palm of glovelet. Cont as set until all 27 (29) chart rows have been worked. Knit 10 rounds plain (or to 1/2" less than desired length).

Work Top band and Thumb as for left glovelet. Weave in ends. Block using your preferred method.

Left Glovelet Chart: Size Large/Extra Large

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Knit 21 sts across palm of left hand, then work chart sts, reading chart from right to left. Cont as set, knitting all palm sts.

**Key to Chart:**  
0 = yarnover  
/ = k2tog  
\ = ssk  
//\ = slip 1, k2tog, pss0 (double dec with left slant)  
/// = k3tog (double dec with right slant)  
Shaded square = no st



Right Glovelet Chart: Size Large/Extra Large

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Work chart sts, reading chart from right to left. Then knit 21 sts across palm of left hand. Cont as set, knitting all palm sts.

**Key to Chart:**  
 0 = yarnover  
 / = k2tog  
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 /\ = slip 1, k2tog, pss0 (double dec with left slant)  
 /// = k3tog (double dec with right slant)  
 Shaded square = no st
