## Hemlock Ring Doily Throw




Original: MATERIALS: J. \& P. COATS' Six CORD MERCER-CROCHET (BLUE LABEL), Size 20: 2 balls of White, or 4 of Ecru. A set of 4 double-pointed steel needles No. 12. Completed doily measures about 15 inches in diameter.

For Large Throw: Cascade Eco Wool 2 skeins ( 250 gms, 478 yds), circular and DPN US Size 10 1/2

NOTE: $\mathrm{O}=$ yarnover $\quad$ sl $1=$ slip 1 st as to knit $\quad$ psso $=$ pass slipped st over st just worked
Use the Emily Ocker cast on for circular knitting -- or preferred method. Starting at the center, cast on 8 sts. Divide the sts on 3 needles and join, being careful not to twist sts.

1st and 2nd rnds: Knit around.
3rd rnd: (O, k 1) 8 times.
4th, 5th and 6th rnds: Knit around.
7th rnd: ( $\mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) 16 times
8th to 12th rnds incl: Knit around.
13th rnd: * K 2 tog, thread over twice, ssk Repeat from * around.
14th rnd: K 1, allow 1st O to slip off left-hand needle, work 9 sts in next O -- to work 9 sts in 1, (k 1, p 1) 4 times; k 1,-- * k 2, drop 1 O, work 9 sts in next O. Repeat from * around, ending with k 1 (88 sts).

15th to 24th rnds incl: Knit around.
25th rnd: ( $\mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 11$ ) 8 times.

26th and all even rnds: Knit around.
27th rnd: (O, k 1, O, k 11) 8 times.
29th rnd: * $\mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} \mathrm{4}$,sll 1 st as if to $\mathrm{k}, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog, psso, k 4 . Repeat from * around ( 112 sts).
31 st rnd : $* \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{sl} 1, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog, psso, $\mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{sl} 1, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog, psso, k 3 . Repeat from * around.
$33 \mathrm{rd} \mathrm{rnd}: * \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{p}$ and k in the next st, $\mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 2$, sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, k 2 . Repeat from * around (136 sts).

35th rnd: * O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, O, k 4, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, (O, k 1) twice; sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, k 1. Repeat from * around.

37th rnd : * O, k 3, O, k 2, ssk, k 2 tog, $\mathrm{k} 2, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{k} 3, \mathrm{O}, \mathrm{sl} 1, \mathrm{k} 2$ tog, psso. Repeat from * around.
39th rnd: * O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, O, k 2, ssk, k 2 tog, k 2, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, PSSO, (O, k 1) 2 times. Repeat from * around.

41st rnd: * (O, k 3) twice; ssk, k 2 tog, (k 3, O) twice; k 1. Repeat from * around (152 sts).
43rd rnd : * O, k 1, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, O, k 3, ssk, k 2 tog, k 3, O, sl 1, k 2 tog, psso, (O, k 1) 2 times. Repeat from * around.

45th rnd: Knit around (there will be 3 rnds of knitting: rnds 44-45-46).
47th rnd: Remove marker and k9 sts. Replace marker and start Rnd 1 of Feather and Fan Chart (Note: the $1^{\text {st }} 9$ sts will be worked at the beg of the round when the marker is moved and again at the end of the rnd). Continue until desired size, ending after 4 rnds of stockinette stitch are complete.

The point of shifting the marker is to change the beginning of the round to a better place for the Feather and Fan section.

Bind Off Rnd:
K 1, * k 2 tog, O , k 2 tog, turn, p 1, work 5 sts in next st -- to work 5 sts in $1(\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1)$ twice in the same st, then k in the same st once more. P 1 , sl 1, turn, bind off 7 sts ( 1 st remains on righthand needle). Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Soak thoroughly in cool water, gently squeeze out excess, pin out into shape and allow to dry completely. Steam press before unpinning.

Alternate bind off: crochet through 3 sts, chain 7, repeat until done.
