9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

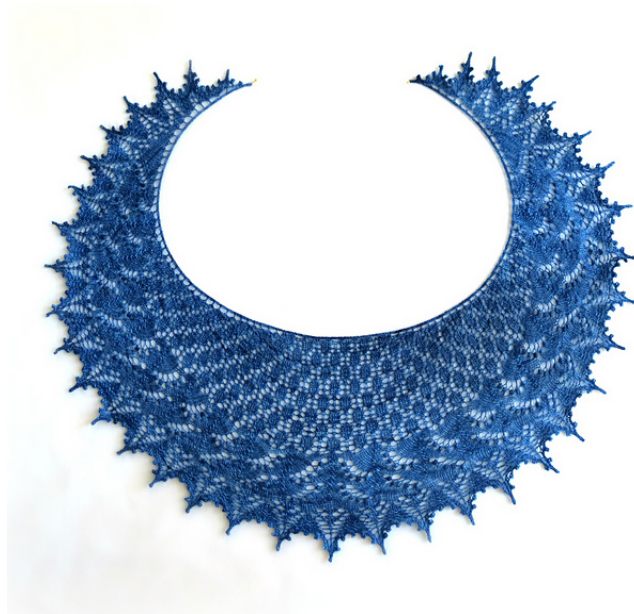
